- Clients are required to sign an acknowledgment that they received the necessary PREA information. are provided with a handbook informing them of their rights and options related to sexual assault, sexual abuse, sexual harassment, and/or retaliation reviewed by a multi-disciplinary committee. Recommendations are reviewed for feasibility and applied to minimize risk for clients. Upon admission, clients Executive staff ensure that policies and procedures are regularly reviewed and updated. - As a result of the reported numbers of sexual abuse that occurred this year, the following preventative measures were put in place:
- Piloting cameras in dormitory areas to deter incidents and creating a new policy that clients are not permitted to change in dormitories with cameras.
- Re-evaluated camera angles and made adjustments to ensure better coverage of the area and placed additional cameras in a kitchen area
- 0 Provided additional training for staff on how to safely enter blind areas such as the freezer area
- Provided additional staff training on trends in gang affiliations
- Reviewed PREA Assessment to determine if any updates were needed at this time
- 0 Installed an enhanced communication tool to increase speed of client to staff communication
- Conducted refresher trainings for all contractors and volunteers
- Continued to provide a high level of required ethics trainings
